<b><i>Powers of Attorney:</i></b>		
I need someone who can make healthcare decisions for me if I become unable to take care of myself.		
I need someone who can manage my finances (e.g. pay bills) if I become unable to take care of myself.		
I need a Power of Attorney for Property or Personal Care.		
<b><i>Employment Law:</i></b>		
I have lost my job.		
My work hours or wages have been cut.		
I have concerns about safe working conditions during COVID-19.		
<b><i>Consumer Protection and Debt:</i></b>		
I am having trouble paying my bills (e.g. credit cards, utilities), or paying my mortgage.		
I am having problems with something I scheduled, bought, or ordered that was disrupted because of COVID-19 (e.g. weddings, travel, or renovations).		
I was targeted with a scam about COVID-19.		
<b><i>Housing:</i></b>		
COVID-19 has created problems with my roommates, lease, or landlord.		
My landlord is threatening me with an eviction.		
<b><i>Corporate Law:</i></b>		
I am a small business owner or non-profit dealing with non-payment of invoices or cancelled contracts or events.		
I am small business owner or non-profit dealing with cashflow problems or expenses I cannot pay.
